Directions to Mountain View Farm

From the North, South, or West, take I-81 exit for Route 30 East at Chambersburg toward Gettysburg. After crossing over South Mountain look for road signs directing you to "Land of Little Horses" and "KOA Campground." These signs will alert you to the right hand turn from Route 30 onto Knoxlyn Road. After making the turn onto Knoxlyn Road, our farm lane entrance will be 1.4 miles on the right. Vehicles with trailers please take the second entrance.

From the North, South, or East, take Route 30 West from Route 15 through the town of Gettysburg. Three miles on Route 30 West from the Gettysburg town square (traffic circle), you will make a left hand turn onto Knoxlyn Road. Road signs for "Land of Little Horses" and "KOA Campground" will alert you to the turn. After making the turn onto Knoxlyn Road, our farm lane entrance will be 1.4 miles on the right. Vehicles with trailers please take the second entrance.
